Relationships and Sexuality Education—Navigating the Journey

In Term 4, Te Māhuri will teach a health unit called 'Relationships and Sexuality Education – Navigating the Journey'. This unit focuses on providing students with the necessary knowledge and learning activities around five themes:

- Establishing a positive learning environment Te whakarite i tētahi ao ako Huapai Respect, inclusiveness, self-worth, listening
- Who am I? Ko wai au?
 Self Worth, Positive body image, equity, stereotypes
- Relationships Ngā whanaungatanga
 Social and physical change, emotions, respect, self-worth, peer pressure, assertiveness, friendships
- Growing and changing Te tipu me te huri o te tangata
 Hygiene, physical and social changes, development needs, body image, gender, stereotypes
- Staying safe Te noho haumaru
 Coping with change, identifying risks and strategies, support

The lessons are structured to reflect the achievement objectives in the Health and Physical Education learning area. Lesson content evolves from Year 0- Year 8 and is taught every two years. This unit of work has been created in consultation with the Ministries of Education and Health, and Family Planning.


