Music Tuition 2025



Maths and Science Badges **Register by Friday 14 March**

Maths

The Mathematics Achievement Challenge aims to extend student learning in mathematics. Students working at Curriculum Level 2 (Years 4-5) may register for CRACA-MAC; students working at Curriculum Levels 3 & 4 (Years 6-8) may enter the MAC awards. Students have all year to complete a badge and may complete more than one, if they wish.

Science

Year 5-8 students may wish to work towards Science Awards Trust badges.

The Year 5 Explorer Badge and Year 6 Advanced Explorer Badge re earned by completing a range of extension activities. Badges for Years 7 and 8 require students to complete advanced activity sheets, in their own time, from a wide range of topics.

School Parent Portals



Caregivers can now access their child/ ren's school information via the caregiver portal on the school's student management system, edge.

The caregiver portal gives parents online access to their child's attendance, school account and, in time, their school achievement data. The portal also enables parents to pay school bills at the click of a button.

To login, you must use the email address that the school holds for you. This is the one you provided with your child's enrolment and is the one that receives newsletters and other email notices from the school.

Option 1

If you already have the SchoolAppsNZ mobile app on your phone, click the *parent portal* button on the opening screen;

Option 2

Enter the website https:// parent.edgelearning.co.nz/ into your browser.

- 1. Type your details into the email field.
- 2. Click 'Forgot Password' to receive an email with a 'reset your password'
- 3. Once logged in, click on your child's name to access:
 - Attendance
 - School Payments Parents can view a balance and a list of items owing, and they can pay online via Ezypay
 - Assessment data and student Reports (available when published by the school).




